What data do we collect?

Custodian Golf collects the following data:

- Personal identification information
 - First name
 - Last name
 - Email address
 - Telephone number
 - Postal address
 - Gender
 - Age

How do we collect your data?

You directly provide Custodian Golf with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- Contact us using any of the forms on our website.
- Voluntarily complete a customer survey or provide feedback via email.
- Use or view our website via your browser's cookies.

How will we use your data?

Custodian Golf collects your data so that we can:

- Process your enquiries and manage your account.
- Contact you with special offers on other products and services we think you might like.
- Invite you to consultations
- Improve the performance of our website and services

How do we store your data?

Custodian Golf securely stores your data and it is encrypted at rest and in transit, using several strong encryption protocols and technologies.

What are your data protection rights?

Custodian Golf would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access – You have the right to request Custodian Golf for copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.

The right to rectification – You have the right to request that Custodian Golf correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to

request Custodian Golf to complete the information you believe is incomplete.

The right to erasure – You have the right to request that Custodian Golf erase your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to restrict processing – You have the right to request that Custodian Golf restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to object to processing – You have the right to object to Custodian Golf's processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to data portability – You have the right to request that Custodian Golf transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions.

What are cookies?

Cookies are text files placed on your computer to collect standard Internet log information and visitor behaviour information. When you visit our websites, we may collect information from you automatically through cookies or similar technology.

How do we use cookies?

Custodian Golf uses cookies in a range of ways to improve your experience on our website, including:

- Understanding how you use our website
- Identify ways to improve our website

- Identify ways in which visitors find our website

For some features on our website, it is necessary to send cookie related data to other countries including the United States.

What types of cookies do we use?

There are a number of different types of cookies, however, our website uses:

- Essential – These are required to enable basic website functionality.
- Marketing – Custodian Golf uses these cookies to collect information about your visit to our website, the content you viewed, the links you followed and information about your browser, device, and your IP address. Custodian Golf sometimes shares some limited aspects of this data with third parties for advertising and marketing purposes. We may also share online data collected through cookies with our advertising partners. This means that when you visit another website, you may be shown advertising based on your browsing patterns on our website.
- Personalisation – Custodian Golf uses these cookies so that we recognize you on our website and remember your previously selected preferences. These could include your cookie preferences. A mix of first-party and third-party cookies are used.
- Analytics – used for monitoring visitor behaviour whilst on our website.

How to manage cookies

You can set your browser not to accept cookies, and the above website tells you how to remove cookies from your browser. However, in a few cases, some of our website features may not function as a result.
